

Regulations for Garbage Disposal Thursday pick-up except for major holidays

Garbage picked up curbside must have the appropriate number of Village Yellow Solid Waste Disposal (SWD) sticker(s) affixed. Garbage will not be picked up without Village SWD stickers affixed.

Village SWD stickers will be available at the Village Clerk's Office during open office hours. Pay with a credit or debit card at https://villageofgreenwich.org/residents/make-a-payment/ Stickers can be mailed to your address.

FEE SCHEDULE:

15-gallon bag – \$3.00 – ONE (1) STICKER 30-gallon bag – \$6.00 – TWO (2) STICKERS 45-gallon bag – \$9.00 – THREE (3) STICKERS

Village SWD stickers are also available at the service desk at Hannaford for your convenience.

Yard waste will be picked up the first and third Monday of each month. Use lawn bags or containers. No plastic bags please. Branches may be bundled and tied up to 5' lengths. Fall only – sweep leaves to curb.

Spring Clean-up Week is an opportunity to get rid of furniture, appliances, scrap metal and assorted household goods. Look for announcement and list of acceptable items and sticker amounts from the Village Clerk each spring.

Regulations for Single Stream Recycling

The Village Collects single-stream recycling on Thursdays. Please use a container or
paper bag – no plastic bags. MUST BE CLEAN!
