Special Budget Workshop – 6pm
Public Hearing on Amendment of Subdivision Regulations

The Board of Trustees of the Village of Greenwich held a Special Meeting for the purpose of presenting the 2026/2027 budget to the Board of Trustees at the Community Center, 6 Academy Street in the Village of Greenwich. Present were Mayor Hurley, Trustees Robinson and Moore as well as Treasurer Clothier. Trustee Grimmke and Trustee Vandewater were absent.

Mayor Hurley opened the meeting at 6:00 pm.

Mayor Hurley opened the **Public Hearing on Amendment of Village of Greenwich Regulations Adopted on September 27, 1971, Entitled, “The Village of Greenwich Land Subdivision Regulations”**

No comment and no members of the public were in attendance.

Public Hearing closed without comment.

Presentation of the 2026/2027 Tentative Budget which has sat on the clerk’s desk since March 20. This budget must be adopted by May 1, 2026. Below are some points discussed:

- Treasurer Clothier budgeted 17.5 hours for Treasurer’s hours. There is a line for Deputy Clerk for 20 hours a week at \$22/hour for 52 weeks.
- The Town’s 2026 budget for fire protection service Schedule 2-A is \$130,965. The revenue was higher in 2024/2025 because of payments from Foreign Fire Insurance for providing mutual aid which was \$17,000. The Fire Department must submit FASNY paperwork to receive it.
- Police Officers hourly to be increased by 3% which is in line with Cambridge and the rest of the Village staff.
- Treasurer Clothier pointed out there are better numbers for revenue (schedule 2-A) from the comptroller which will be forthcoming.

Public Hearing on the budget will be held at the regular meeting on April 13, 2026, at 7pm.

Signage and tree donation from Washington County Soil and Water Conservation District – Trustee Moore would like to have Mandy’s Nursery plant the donated Pin Oak in Gannon Park pending placement approval from Superintendent Smith and Mayor Hurley. Temporary educational signage will be up for the summer along with a permanent sign. This will be the location for the April 24th Arbor Day celebration along with a dedication and sapling giveaways.
